Sadly, one of the main items yet again is different types of scams that are happening and can we once again take this opportunity to remind everyone to be extra vigilant, especially this time of year. Always report or forward items to action fraud.

As you are aware SPR recently submitted applications for East Anglia One North and East Anglia Two offshore windfarms. These applications have been submitted to the Planning Inspectorate and seek a Development Consent Order under the 2008 Planning Act. As a result the local authority is just a consultee and not the determining body.

The intention is for a report to be taken to Strategic Planning Committee on 9th December 2019 which will seek the committee's support for Cllr Rivett as the Cabinet Member for Economic Development to seek delegated authority in conjunction with the Head of Planning and Coastal Management, from Cabinet in order to respond to requests for information and documents and represent the Council during the examinations of the projects.

It has also been recommended that the members from the Strategic Planning Committee, undertake their own site visit and an illustrative plan has been provided to them of the EA1N, EA2 and National Grid substation site immediately north of Friston village in Appendix C. The plan given to them identifies some key viewpoints and Grove Road from where it would be useful to view the proposed development from.
