

Dear Melanie and Karen

My name is Peter Palmer and I am an Aldeburgh Councillor and chair of our town council's services committee. Recently we have been drawing up a comprehensive plan, in terms of signs and speed limits for the Aldeburgh road network.

One of the issues that surfaced was the A1094 from our parish boundary to the 30 mph limit at the Golf Club. It was felt, that having received complaints and concerns because of the number of turnings, the speed of traffic and the dips, that a reduced speed limit here would be appropriate. 40 mph perhaps. However it was then brought up that there were less than inspiring junctions at the Knodishall and Friston turnings and it was suggested that a 50 mph limit from just before the corner to our 30 mph limit might be more sensible. It was then proposed that the whole section from Snape 30 mph to Aldeburgh 30 mph might be usefully reduced to 50 mph to save a confusing array of limit changes and to limit speed into the Snape 30 mph limit in the other direction.

As you can see the range and scope has increased materially beyond our own remit. As any changes beyond our Parish boundary necessarily involves both your PCs we thought it wise to seek your opinions on the matter before going any further with formulating any proposals.
