These set out the process and criteria that would need to be met if a speed limit was to be changed.

The process would include me or my Area colleagues carrying out a brief assessment as to whether the request has a chance of meeting the criteria. If it's unlikely to succeed we will advise as such. If it may meet the criteria, and your County Councillor, Andrew Reid, is supportive of your request he would need to contact our Local Highway Budget team, in Ipswich, to discuss commissioning them to carry out a full assessment. Once the County Council elections are completed in May we may then be advised of how the assessment will be processed.

I'll endeavour to carry out my initial assessment shortly after the Easter break and advise further.
